

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that New York SMSA Limited Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless (“Verizon Wireless”) and Homeland Towers, LLC (“Homeland Towers”) (collectively, the “Applicants”), will perform a balloon test at 101 Bloomer Road, North Salem, NY, Section 6, Block 1748, Lot 3 (the “Site”), in connection with their application to the North Salem Planning Board for a conditional use permit and site development plan approval to locate a wireless communications facility (the “Facility”) at the Site.

The Facility is proposed to include a 120 foot single-pole with exterior-mounted panel antennas thereon, together with related equipment located within a secure fenced 5625 square foot area at the base thereof.

The balloon test will be conducted on Saturday, March 22, 2014 at the Site, or in case of inclement or windy weather, each consecutive weekend date thereafter until the balloon test is completed. The balloon test will commence at approximately 9:00 am and continue for approximately 4 to 8 hours weather permitting. The purpose of the balloon test is to establish the approximate location and height of the Facility so that computer generated visual renderings can be prepared by the Applicants from various viewpoints. The balloon test will consist of an approximately four foot diameter brightly colored balloon being floated on a tether line to a maximum height of 120 feet above ground level. Flags will be placed on the tether at heights of 110, 100 and 90 feet above ground level.
